

Hampden Superior Court:

The Hampden Superior Court Clerk's Office no longer accepts Civil filings by email. Counsel should send Civil filings via US mail as pre-pandemic. The Superior Court Clerk's Office will not be open for hand-delivery, but there will be a drop box for the Superior Court in the front entrance of the Roderick L. Ireland Courthouse, and it will be checked in the morning and at 2:00 p.m.

The Hampden Superior Court Clerk's Office no longer accepts electronic filings in Criminal Cases, with the exception ONLY for criminal pleadings (e.g., motions, bail petitions, status and pre-trial reports, etc.) that are **five (5) pages or less**, which may be delivered by email to: hampden.clerksoffice@jud.state.ma.us. Any and all Attachments, Exhibits, Memoranda and other supplemental documents attendant to such electronically filed criminal pleadings (as well as any criminal pleadings exceeding five (5) pages) must be filed separately via US mail, or may be delivered via the aforementioned Superior Court Drop Box.

In the event the filing of a criminal pleading is time sensitive (i.e., a scheduled hearing within two (2) days of the filing, etc.), Counsel should indicate same within the email for electronically filed pleadings, and in writing by cover letter or otherwise for pleadings filed by U.S. Mail or delivered via the Superior Court Drop Box.
